Supported by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, this initiative tackles some of the most critical public health challenges in India. With the endorsement of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Indian Council for Medical Research, it aligns seamlessly with national and state-level (Uttar Pradesh and Bihar) health priorities and exemplifies a solutions-oriented approach to public health.

The initiative is powered by partnerships with premier institutions, including the **National Institute** for Research in Tuberculosis, IIM Bodhgaya, and the **National Disease Modelling Consortium** at IIT Bombay, alongside 15 other esteemed organizations and global collaborators such as **The Union**. This program transcends being a mere response to health challenges; it serves as a strategic

blueprint for advancing equity in healthcare delivery and improving health outcomes across diverse communities.

Equally pivotal is WCF's work on women's safety and empowerment. In collaboration with National Law University (NLU), Delhi, WCF is conducting a comprehensive study on women's safety across four locations: NLU Odisha, NLU Assam, RRU Gandhinagar, and NLU Delhi. While the report is being finalized, it has already begun to inform national conversations and policy frameworks, laying the foundation for impactful interventions to address systemic barriers.

WCF's focus on empowerment extends to economic inclusion, underscored by its **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Loomba Foundation.** This initiative is skilling 100,000 widows, equipping them with sustainable livelihood opportunities and creating pathways for self-reliance. It reflects WCF's broader vision of enabling vulnerable women to achieve economic independence and dignity.

#### **Driving Global Impact**

In its commitment to addressing maternal health disparities, WCF has deployed postpartum hemorrhage (PPH) drapes across critical states such as Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Chhattisgarh, and extended these life-saving interventions to regions in Africa. These cost-effective measures address one of the leading causes of maternal mortality, bridging healthcare gaps across the Global South and ensuring that interventions transcend borders to serve vulnerable populations. Supported by local healthcare providers and global partners, these efforts are setting benchmarks for scalable, equitable healthcare solutions.

WCF's global vision is exemplified by its active participation in the **Global Gender Alliance** at the **World Economic Forum (WEF).** As a contributor to this prestigious platform, WCF is amplifying the voices of the **Global South**, ensuring that the unique challenges and opportunities of these regions remain central to global conversations.

By addressing issues such as gender equity, economic inclusion, and systemic change, WCF is shaping international policies while showcasing the Global South as a key player in driving equitable and inclusive development. Its engagement at the WEF highlights WCF's leadership in shaping conversations that connect local realities with global frameworks.
